A. Schneider feels the need to be flexible and the needs for staffing will change year to year. Need to be careful to lay off firefighters/EMS on a regular basis or they won't come back.

S. Hazeltine asked Lt./Paramedic Pinnow what EMS is looking for in the future. What concerns does the EMS board have if there was to be a dissolution of the Brodhead Fire Dist. after a possible merger in future. Lt./Paramedic Pinnow could not answer for the EMS board. He himself has several concerns if the EMS was to merge with the Brodhead Fire Dist. S. Hazeltine felt the two boards should meet to talk over the concerns. If a future merger were to happen concerns need to be addressed.
